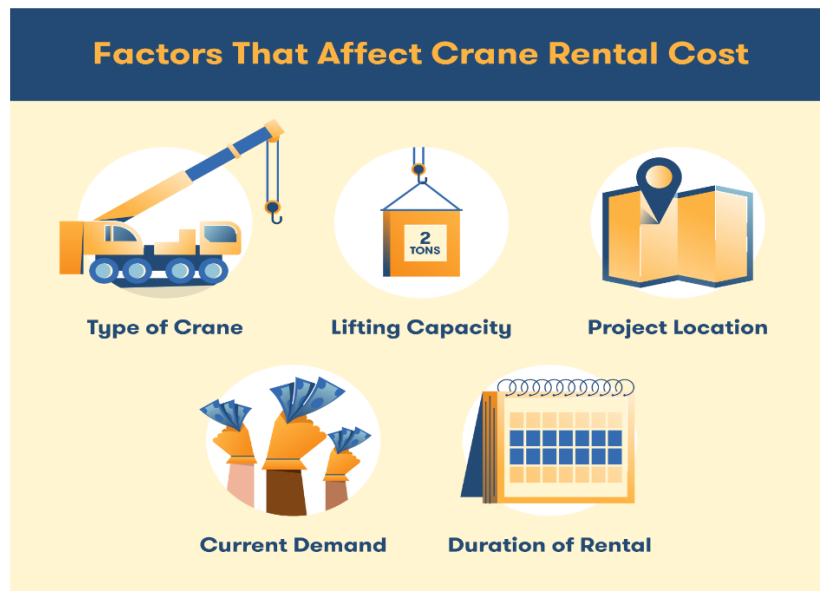
Crane rental rate costs vary based on many factors, so the only way to get an accurate price is to request a quote. Because there are hundreds of models of cranes with different features and specifications, there is no simple answer about how much it costs to rent a crane. Nonetheless, it helps to have some idea of rental costs. Generally speaking, small mobile cranes cost around from \$100 per hour to rent and large operated cranes cost closer to \$500 per hour, while large tower cranes can cost around \$15,000 to rent for a month. Besides the rental cost, make sure you consider additional costs that may be involved:

- **Delivery and assembly:** Many cranes must be delivered to the job site, like crawler cranes, or even assembled, like tower cranes.
- **Permits:** Often, cranes require permits to operate, so check with your local jurisdiction to understand the costs and paperwork involved.
- **Qualified personnel:** All cranes require NCCCO qualified operators, riggers and signal persons, which are necessary for safe lifting.
- **Other fees:** Specialized rigging, preparing a lift plan, paying for overtime and other costs come along with renting a crane.

These fees, though, are only a part of the factors that go into determining a crane's total rental cost.

Factors That Affect Rental Cost

A number of factors go into the final rental cost for a crane, and understanding them will help you make a good decision for your particular needs.

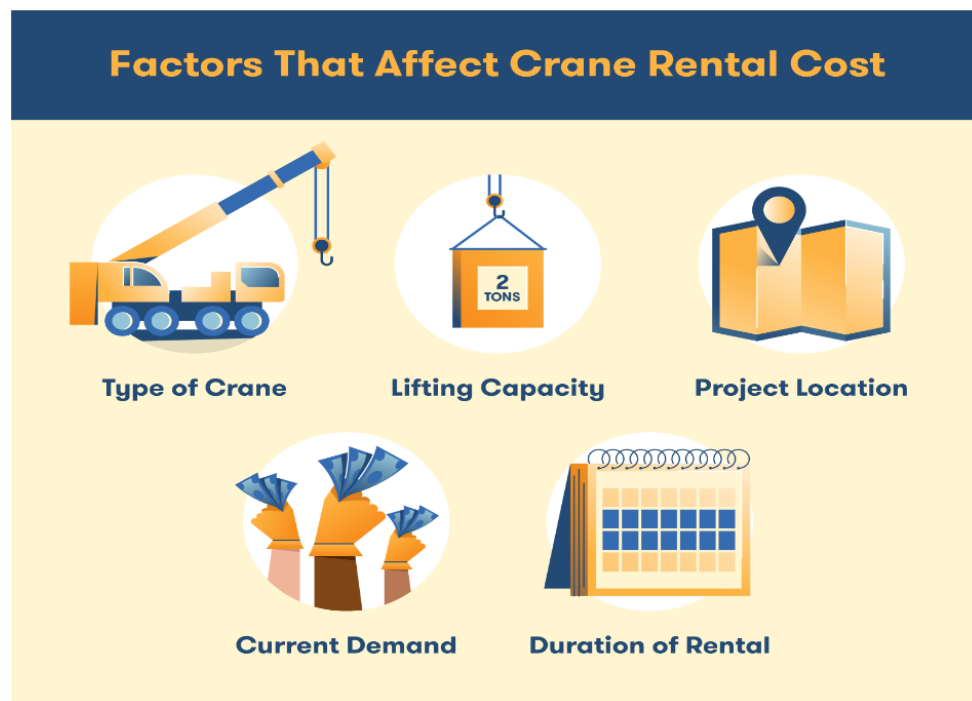


These are the most important factors in determining the cost to rent a crane:

- **Type of crane:** Depending on the type of crane you rent, costs will range from hundreds to tens of thousands of dollars. Small carry-deck cranes will be inexpensive, whereas operated cranes or tower cranes will cost much more.
- **Lifting capacity:** The more that a crane can lift, the more expensive it will be. Some of the largest mobile cranes can lift more than 1,000 tons.
- **Location:** Depending on the country or state you're renting in, prices can vary dramatically.
- **Duration of rental:** While it is always more expensive to rent a crane for a longer period of time, the cost per day drops dramatically when you rent a crane on a weekly or monthly basis.
- **Current demand:** During construction booms, cranes are in high demand, and costs can rise significantly.

Considering all of these factors will help you better understand what you're looking at when you request a quote for a crane rental.

You may also want to consider whether it makes more sense to rent a crane or purchase one depending on your particular situation.
